






Timeline of Egyptian History

- 2181-2055 BC First Intermediate Period (126 years)
- 2055-1650 BC The Middle Kingdom (405 years)
- 1650-1550 BC Second Intermediate Period (100 years)
- 1550-1069 BC **The New Kingdom** (481 years)
- 1069-653 BC Third Intermediate Period (416 years)
- 664-332 BC The Late (Achaemenid) Period (415 years)
- 332-30 BC The Ptolemaic Period (302 years)
- 30 BC-641 AD Roman & Byzantine Period (671 years)
- 641-1517 AD **Arab & Muslim Periods** (876 years)
- 1517-1867 AD Ottoman Empire Period (350 years)




Early Dynastic Period (3100–2686 BC)


