

# The End of War – Key Dates

# <u>1918</u>

Aug 8-Nov 11 – Hundred Days Offensive, last on Western Front. Aug 26-Sept 1 – Battle of Baku, last Turkish offensive. Sept 18-Oct 17 – Allies break through German lines. <u>Sept 19-25 – British conquer Palestine.</u> Sept 26-27 – British capture Damascus. Sept 30 – Bulgaria signs armistice with Allies. Oct 30 – Ottoman Empire signs Armistice of Mudros. Nov 3 – Austria-Hungary signs armistice with Italy. Nov 9 – German Kaiser Wilhelm II abdicates; republic declared. Nov 10 – Austro-Hungarian Kaiser Charles I abdicates. Nov 11 – 6 AM: Germany signs Armistice of Complegne Nov 11 - 11 AM: hostilities cease. Nov 12 – Austria proclaimed a republic. 1919 Jan 18 – Paris Peace Conference June 28 – Treaty of Versailles


